PRESENTATION OF LETTERS OF CREDENCE BY H.E. MOHAMMAD AZHAR MAZLAN TO H.E. ENRIQUE PEÑA NIETO PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED MEXICAN STATES



His Excellency Mohammad Azhar Mazlan, Ambassador-designate of Malaysia to the United Mexican States presented his Letters of Credence to His Excellency Enrique Peña Nieto, President of the United Mexican States on 11 May 2016. He is the eighth Ambassador to represent Malaysia in Mexico since the formalization of relations between Malaysia and Mexico forty two years ago. During the Ceremony at the National Palace, the Ambassador was accompanied by Madam Amelia Azhar, Mr. Khornelisman Jasri, Second Secretary and Mr. Mohd. Hafiz Abdul Jalil, Trade Commissioner of the Embassy of Malaysia in Mexico.

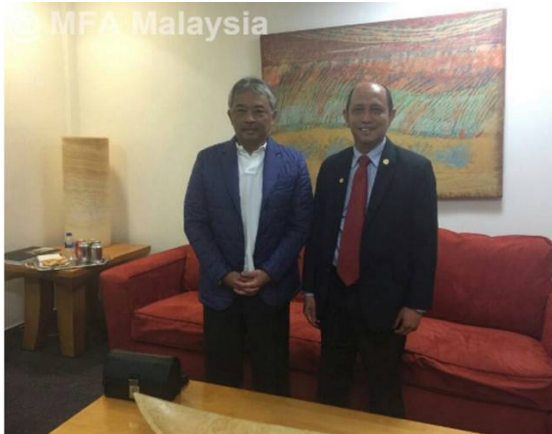
The state of bilateral relations between Malaysia and Mexico has been excellent. Mexico is Malaysia's strategic partner in the Central American region. Mexico is Malaysia's largest trading partner and also Malaysia's largest export destination as well as the largest import source in the region. In 2015, Malaysia's exports to Mexico amounted to USD1.59 billion, while Malaysia's imports from Mexico amounted to USD383.1 million registering a total trade of USD1.97 billion.

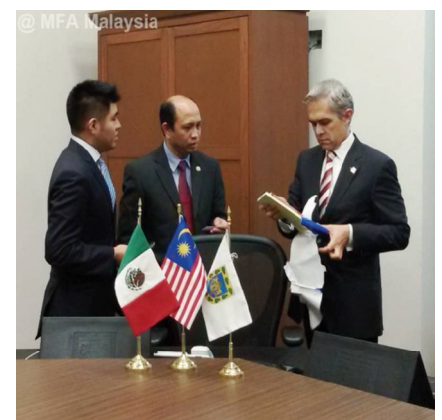

Things-to-do in Mexico

MOSQUE IN MEXICO CITY – POLANCO

Located at Polanco the northwest of Mexico City, the *Centro Educativa de la Comunidad Musulmana A.C.* (Educational Center of the Muslim Community) in Mexico City caters for 200 and 300 Muslims, where Muslim ambassadors from different countries and their Home Based Staff pray at the mosque every Fridays. According to the Mexican National Institute of Statistics and Geography (INEGI), in its document Panorama of Religions in Mexico 2010, there are 3,760 Muslims in the country, most of them in Mexico City (1,178), State of Mexico (417) and Jalisco (248). The local government supports the practices of different religions through contributions and places where they can freely practice their religion and its festivities.



SUNDAY MORNINGS: BICYCLE DAY



Stand on Mexico City's grand Paseo de la Reforma boulevard every Sunday morning and you will hear gears whirring, bells ringing and the chatter of voices as 50,000 people cycle, scoot and skate along 35 km of closed roads. This sprawling megacity of 21 million is home to 5.5m cars, and that number is growing despite some of the worst traffic jams in the world. Residents spend an average of three hours a day commuting, and car speeds during rush hour have fallen to around 12km/h. For

one day every week, though, people on bikes and on foot rule a decent stretch of road, for a few hours at least. The official Muévete en Bici (Move by Bike) event has been going since 2008 but was recently expanded to cover 55km of city streets. It is not just for cyclists: many others jog with baby strollers, or enjoy free zumba classes, martial arts or Mexican wrestling displays.
