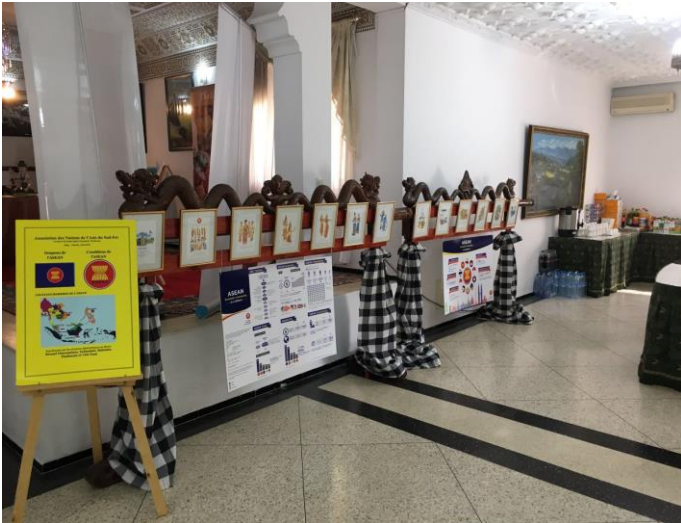
Inauguration of the ASEAN Committee in Rabat (ACR), 4 February 2016

The inauguration of the ASEAN Committee in Rabat (ACR) was held at the Embassy of Indonesia, 4 February 2016. The ACR formal process started when the request to establish the ACR was sent to the ASEAN Secretary General during the period when Ambassador Pham Truong Giang of Viet Nam chaired the Group of ASEAN Heads of Mission in 2014. The approval for the establishment of the ACR by the ASEAN Committee of Permanent Representatives in Jakarta was conveyed through its Chair on 5 November 2015. The event was held to formalize the establishment of the ACR. H.E. E.D. Syarief Syamsuri, Ambassador of Indonesia, the current Chair of the ACR and Mr. Mohamed Maliki, Director of Asian and Oceanic Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation of Morocco, delivered speeches to commemorate the event. Ambassadors of Malaysia, Thailand and Viet Nam, and the Charge d'Affaires of Brunei were also present. Guests were invited to view a mini exhibition showcasing the handicrafts of the five ASEAN Member States currently in Rabat, namely Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Viet Nam and Brunei. There were also informative posters on ASEAN, especially on the ASEAN Economic Community. Guests were also treated to various ASEAN delicacies prepared by the five ASEAN Embassies.
