### 13 January 2016

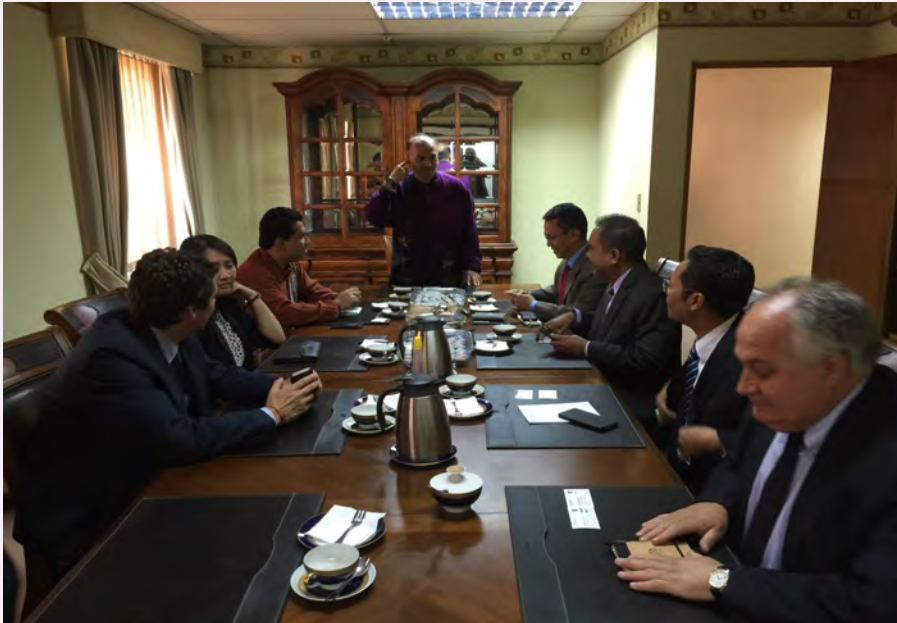

The said meeting was to inform on the re-establishment of the ASEAN Committee in Santiago as well as to deliberate matters relating to ASEAN and Chile. During the said meeting Dr. Rameez as the current Chairman of the ASEAN Committee in Santiago spoke on behalf of the ASEAN group.

Among others, Dr. Rameez updated the Deputy Minister on ASEAN's activities namely the ASEAN Luncheon Talk, ASEAN Bowling Tournament, the ASEAN Futsal Game which will be held in March 2016 and the ASEAN Fair which scheduled to be held on 7 April 2016. ## 'TIADA ISTILAH BERLEMBUT'

**MUKADIMAH** MENTERI Luar, DATUK SERI ANIFAH AMAN turut menyentuh isu tuntutan bertindih wilayah maritim di Laut China Selatan dan penembakan pesawat MH17 ketika bercakap sasaran pelan strategik kementeriannya untuk

"Ini sesuai dengan peranan Malaysia kini sebagai ahli tidak tetap Majlis Keselamatan Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu (PBB)," kata beliau kepada wartawan *Mingguan Malaysia*, ZULKIFLI JALIL dan KASTHURI JEEVENDRAN di Putrajaya baru-baru ini.

**M**INGGUAN: Memasuki Tahun Baharu 2016, ada pihak mahu Malaysia menggerakkan dasar luar yang lebih berani dan tegas? Adakah Pelan Strategik Kementerian Luar Negeri bagi tempoh 2016-2020 ke arah itu?

**ANIFAH:** Tempoh 2016 sehingga 2020 merupakan tempoh lima tahun terakhir bagi Malaysia untuk merealisasikan matlamatnya untuk menjadi negara maju dan inklusif pada 2020. Dalam hal ini, Wisma Putra, sebagai pelaksana utama dasar luar negara tidak terkecuali dalam berusaha mencapai matlamat ini kerana dasar luar Malaysia sendiri dipengaruhi oleh dasar-dasar domestik.

Selama ini, dasar luar Malaysia sentiasa berani dan tegas dalam mempertahankan keselamatan dan kedaulatan negara serta pragmatik dalam menyuarakan pendirian Malaysia dalam isu-isu yang berkepentingan di arena

antarabangsa.

Malaysia juga sentiasa peka dengan persekitaran global yang sering berubah melibatkan isu-isu antarabangsa yang semakin kompleks seperti keganasan, jenayah rentas sempadan, migrasi, hak asasi manusia, perubahan iklim dan isu-isu alam sekitar yang lain. Cabaran-cabaran ini perlu ditangani dengan baik dan berkesan demi mempertahankan kedaulatan dan keutuhan negara serta memelihara kepentingan negara untuk menjamin masa depan generasi yang akan datang.

Oleh itu, Malaysia akan melaksanakan dasar luar yang bertanggungjawab dan konsisten berprinsipkan rasa hormat kepada kebebasan, kedaulatan dan keutuhan wilayah, sikap tidak mencampuri urusan dalaman negara lain, penyelesaian masalah secara aman, kewujudan bersama secara harmoni dan menjalinkan hubungan yang saling



memanfaatkan.

Selaras dengan Dokumen Rancangan Malaysia ke-11 yang dilancarkan Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak pada Mei lalu, Malaysia akan giat memainkan peranan globalnya sebagai "suara di persada antarabangsa" atau *international voice of reason*. Pelan Strategik Kementerian Luar Negeri ini dirangka bagi memperkukuhkan lagi keupayaan Malaysia di peringkat diplomasi dua hala, diplomasi pelbagai hala, diplomasi ASEAN dan diplomasi awam serta memperkasakan penyampaian perkhidmatan untuk para pelanggan dan pihak berkepentingan melalui pemanutapan Wisma Putra sebagai satu institusi dengan modal insannya yang berkebolehan melaksanakan usaha diplomatik yang berkesan untuk menjaga kepentingan negara. Ini seterusnya membolehkan Malaysia terus menyumbang kepada dunia yang adil, aman dan sejahtera.

**Apakah lagi, ada mendakwa kedudukan Malaysia dalam kes penembakan pesawat MH17 ibarat gajah dengan gajah bergaduh, pendakwa mati di tengah-tengah? Justeru, apa tindakan yang telah diambil Wisma Putra setakat ini?**

**ANSWER:** Sebagai negara pemilik pesawat MH17 dan juga keram sebilangan besar mangsa MH17 adalah warganya, Malaysia mempunyai posisi yang kuat di dalam JIT di mana pendirian negara diambil berat dan dihormati oleh ahli-ahli JIT yang lain dan juga masyarakat antarabangsa termasuk Amerika dan Rusia. Malaysia akan sentiasa memastikan bahawa hak-haknya terpelihara dalam isu ini. Oleh itu, tidak akan timbul situasi seperti yang didakwa dalam soalan yang dikemukakan.

**Apakah misi Malaysia sebagai ahli tidak tetap Majlis Keselamatan Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu untuk tahun depan (2016) ini. Adakah ini termasuk meredakan konflik di Palestin dan Syria?**

**ANSWER:** Sebagai ahli tidak tetap Majlis Keselamatan PBB bagi penggal 2015 - 2016, Malaysia akan terus memikul tanggungjawab dalam menyumbangkan ke arah usaha memelihara keamanan dan keselamatan sejagat. Malaysia juga akan terus mengetengahkan dan menggalakkan dasar dan pendirian negara berhubung penyelesaian konflik berteraskan kepada agenda

keselamatan dan mandulan secara damai.

Koaman dan keselamatan sejagat amat penting bagi membolehkan Malaysia untuk terus menjalin hubungan dan mengadakan kerjasama dengan negara-negara lain dalam pelbagai bidang. Ini akan menyumbang kepada keselamatan, kemakmuran dan pembangunan negara ke arah mencapai status negara berpendapatan tinggi menjelang 2020.

**Malaysia berpendirian bahawa ciri-ciri geografi seperti terumbu, beting, cay dan sebagainya yang terdapat dalam kawasan maritim Malaysia di Laut China Selatan merupakan kepunyaan Malaysia. Kehubungan itu, usaha-usaha sentiasa diambil bagi menzahirkan hak dan kedaulatan Malaysia ke atas ciri-ciri geografi ini.**

**Untuk menjayakan pelan strategik Kementerian Luar ini tentu sekali Malaysia bergantung kepada kewibawaan duta-dutanya serta perwakilan yang ditempatkan di negara berkenaan. Setakat ini bagaimana tahap Petunjuk Prestasi Utama (KPI) mereka. Berapa yang diberi surat amaran dan dihantar balik?**

**ANSWER:** Kejayaan melaksanakan Pelan Strategik Kementerian Luar Negeri memerlukan usaha, dedikasi dan komitmen secara kolektif semua warga Kementerian di dalam dan luar negara. Sudah pasti kewibawaan duta-duta dan ketua-ketua perwakilan menjadi elemen penting bagi memastikan kejayaan dalam pelaksanaan serta pencapaian objektif strategik dan sasaran yang ditetapkan.

Pelaksanaan KPI Ketua Perwakilan merupakan inisiatif Kementerian Luar Negeri dalam menilai pelaksanaan objektif dan sasaran serta keberkesanan penyampaian perkhidmatan di

luar negara, termasuk kepada rakyat Malaysia. Kementerian Luar menetapkan indikator dan sasaran pencapaian serta Scorecard untuk ketua-ketua perwakilan berasaskan program dan aktiviti utama yang dijalankan berteraskan objektif-objektif strategik dan hala tuju Pelan Strategik 2016-2020.

Oleh yang demikian, timelime dan sasaran telah disediakan sebagai mekanisme dalaman Kementerian untuk memantau aktiviti dan pelaporan konsisten daripada ketua-ketua perwakilan dalam menyampaikan maklumat, keberhasilan dan pencapaian mereka di luar negara. Mekanisma dalaman ini membantu pihak Kementerian untuk mengurangkan kelemahan tertentu dalam proses penyampaian perkhidmatan di luar negara dan juga membantu merangka strategi yang sesuai untuk meningkatkan peranan Malaysia di persada antarabangsa.

Sehingga kini, ketua-ketua perwakilan telah menunjukkan prestasi yang baik bagi memastikan Malaysia terus memainkan peranan yang aktif dan cemerlang di peringkat antarabangsa. Hasil kerjasama ini dapat dilihat apabila antaranya Malaysia memenangi kerusi tidak tetap Majlis Keselamatan PBB bagi tempoh 2015-2016 dan kepengerusan ASEAN oleh Malaysia pada tahun ini. Cabaran dalam mengendalikan hubungan antarabangsa bukan perkara yang mudah. Saya, selaku Menteri Luar Negeri yakin dengan komitmen, prestasi dan profesionalisme yang telah ditunjukkan oleh warga Wisma Putra dalam menjalankan tugas dan tanggungjawab yang dimanulatkan demi kepentingan negara tercinta.

**Kadangkala dalam isu tertentu contohnya penahanan seorang Pegawai Waran II di New Zealand kerana salah laku seksual mengejutkan banyak pihak dan mencemur imej negara. Adakah suspek ada kaitan dengan Wisma Putra. Kalau tidak ada kaitan, mengapa?**

**ANSWER:** Dalam Sistem Pentadbiran Kerajaan Malaysia (SPKM), Kementerian Luar berperanan sebagaiurus setia yang memantau urusan-urusan berkaitan penugasan Pegawai-pegawai Kerajaan Malaysia di luar negeri. Namun pemilihan pegawai-pegawai kerajaan yang bertugas di luar negara dari Kementerian Lain merupakan hak mutlak Kementerian tersebut.

Dalam kes Pegawai Waran II Rizalman, beliau merupakan bekas staf Pembantu Pertahanan kepada Pesaihan Pertahanan Malaysia di New Zealand yang telah ditugaskan ke New Zealand oleh Kementerian Pertahanan. Beliau kini sedang dibicarakan di Mahkamah Tinggi Wellington.

### Proton Preve and Exora – first exports arrive in Chile

Back in November last year, it was reported that national carmaker Proton was set to make an **official return into the Chilean market** with three models, the **Preve**, **Exora** and **Saga**, all in left-hand drive configuration.

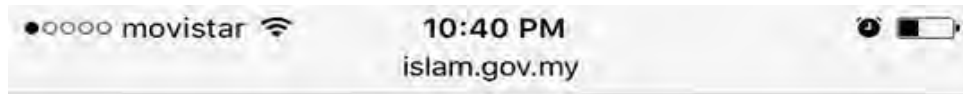
Malaysian ambassador to Chile, Datuk Dr Mohammad Rameez Yahaya, had revealed the developments on his Facebook page. The first cars were set to arrive in December as test cars, with the cars being launched by April, with distributor Andes Motor representing the brand in the country.

Now, the first cars have arrived in Santiago, according to the ambassador, who posted photos of the Proton Preve and Exora being handed over to Andes Motor at its facility, located at Americo Vespucio Quilicura, on his Facebook page. The handing-over ceremony last week was attended by Dr Rameez as well as Andes Motor's business development manager Maximiliano Sfeir and general manager, Jorge Greene.

Andes Motor is set to import a minimum of 500 Proton cars annually over the next five years, and according to the ambassador, the deal will increase trade between both countries by up to USD\$6 million (RM26.2 million) a year.

Proton's venture into the South American country dates back to the 1990s. The national carmaker previously sold the Wira and the **Satria** there. Back in 2013, reports had indicated that there was a strong possibility of a first-exports-arrive-in-chile/proton-chile-facebook-1/ ment of the Malaysia-Chile Free Trade Agreement (FTA).
