KUALA LUMPUR 25 Feb. – Isteri Perdana Menteri, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor menyarankan semua syarikat milik kerajaan (GLC) dan swasta supaya menggalakkan pekerja mereka memakai batik pada setiap Khamis, dalam usaha menggalakkan industri batik negara.

Food diplomacy enhances culture, food in foreign land – Envoy

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 23: Promoting Malaysian food in a foreign country is not all about satisfying one's appetite, it is also about enhancing the Malaysian culture and food in a foreign land.

Malaysian Ambassador to Chile Datuk Dr Mohamad Rameez Yahaya believed in this.

"I believe in food diplomacy as a means to enhance one's own culture and food in a foreign land, what more a nation that is like more than 15,000km away," he said in his welcoming remarks at the two-day Malaysian food promotion held at the Sheraton Hotel in Santiago Monday.

The event, a collaboration between the Malaysian embassy in Santiago and the Sheraton Hotel Santiago, could also be a good platform to strengthen bilateral ties, he said in a statement to Bernama.

The envoy hoped that the event could generate continued interest among the people of Chile to acquire "Malaysian taste and its food." "Through this kind of event, people-to-people link can also be enhanced thus leading to beneficial bilateral relations," he said in a message to Bernama.

Mohamad Rameez also appreciated the presence of Malaysian celebrity chef, Chef Wan, who showcased his expertise in cooking Malaysian cuisine, which is rich in its diversity – with Malay, Indian and Chinese influence.

The envoy said that he would like to see more exchanges of chefs between both nations as "food ambassadors" via similar events.

According to the ambassador, Malaysian community in Santiago, Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP) alumni members and ambassadors from Vietnam, India, Algeria, Haiti and Turkey attended the event.

Chileans who have businesses with Malaysia like Andes Motor that will be importing Malaysia's proton cars into Chile in May, also attended the function, he said.

The ambassador also thanked the embassy's staff and the "Malaysian Ladies Association of Santiago (Perwakilan), who worked hard to ensure the success of the event.

BONGAWAN: Malaysians travelling abroad are advised to inform Malaysian embassies in their destination countries.

Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Anifah Aman said that although it is not compulsory, it is imperative as it enables the ministry to obtain accurate data on the number of Malaysians in a particular country.

"This is not limited to Malaysian students studying abroad but it also applies to those who travel for leisure or any other purposes.

"Otherwise, it will be difficult for the ministry to get accurate information on Malaysians should anything happened in that particular country.

"The instruction has been there but since it is on voluntary basis, not more than 20 per cent registered themselves," he said when met during a walkabout here yesterday in conjunction with the Chinese New Year.

To a question on the progress of upgrading Kimanis to a full district, Anifah who is also Kimanis Member of Parliament said that it is at the final stage of implementation, which should be completed by the year end.

He said that the authorities have identified several locations for the centre of the future district to be considered.

"We have not decided on the name of the district yet as it is still at discussion stage, because it is for the people. We will discuss with other people representatives on the most suitable location for the convenience of the people," he added.

Speaking of the event, he said that it is his normal practice where he, along with the parliament's two state assemblymen would greet the Chinese community a happy new year.

He said that it is a tradition for him where he also gets the chance to meet the people and thank them for supporting Barisan Nasional.





Meanwhile, Bongawan Assemblyman Datuk Mohamad Alamin said that Chinese New Year is part of the country's culture, therefore it should be celebrated together.

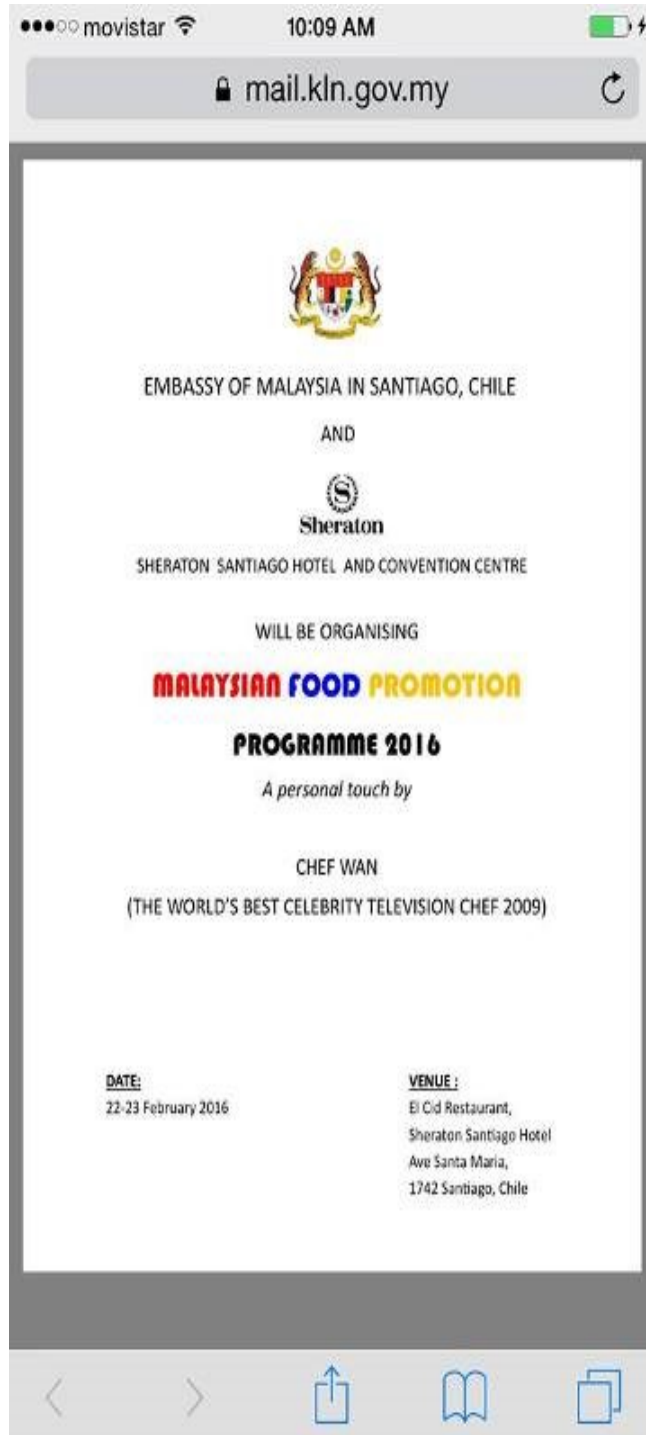
