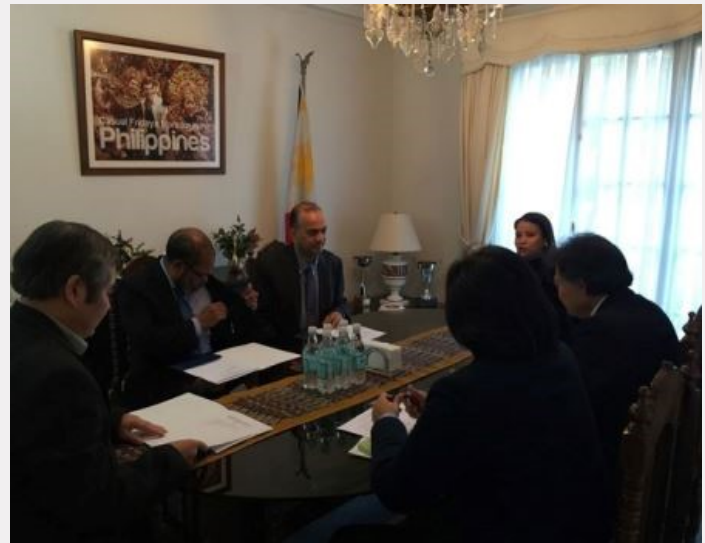

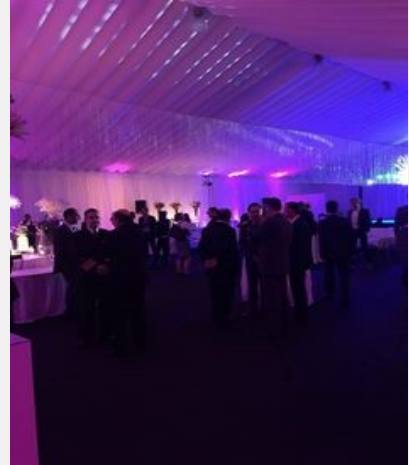

Malaysia Looks To Enhance Trade, Investment Ties With Chile

SANTIAGO, May 24 (Bernama) – Trade and investment ties between Malaysia and Chile are set to be further enhanced with the start of a "Seminar on Business Opportunities with Malaysia" here today.

Organised by the Malaysian External Trade and Development Cooperation (Matrade), the seminar which showcases Malaysian products and services, has received an overwhelming response from the business community here with 150 participants.

Sharing Malaysia's success in managing its economy, Matrade Senior Director, Strategic Planning, Wan Latiff Wan Musa called on the Chilean business community to leverage on the existing Free Trade Agreement (FTA), signed between the two countries in 2012.

He said they should also take advantage of Malaysia's competitive edge in terms of attracting Chilean businesses and investments and use the country as a gateway to enter and capture the ASEAN market.

This follows the immense opportunities available to them following implementation of the ASEAN Economic Community.

"In 2015, Malaysia recorded US\$375.8 billion in total trade with a five per cent gross domestic (GDP) growth.

"Malaysia is a very open economy. The value of total trade is much higher than that of the GDP. We will continue with this approach in enhancing international trade, including with Chile," Wan Latiff said in his keynote address at the opening of the seminar.

He said Malaysia had a more diversified economic structure now, which establishes the foundation for future growth.

"Due to domestic and external factors, last year we record the five per cent growth and it was six per cent in 2014. Domestic demand will remain the key driver of growth led by private sectors spending," he added.

He noted that Malaysia's total trade with Chile in 2015 stood at US\$415.2 million. Total exports were at US\$222.8 million, and imports at US\$192.5 million.

Wan Latiff said Malaysia's major exports to Chile were electrical and electronics products (photosensitive semi-conductor devices, diodes, and microwave ovens) worth US\$109.3 million.

Wood products comprising wooden furniture stood at US\$23.1 million, rubber products including rubber gloves, tubes, pipes and hoses, hard rubber & articles of rubber were worth US\$23.1 million.

Chemicals & chemicals products, fertilisers, alcohols & phenols, soap, cleansing and polishing preparation came to US\$18.4 million.

Palm oil & palm based products comprising vegetable fat & oil, palm oil and palm kernel oil posted US\$109.3 million.

The seminar here is the last leg of the trade and investment mission from May 14 to 27, to three countries, namely Peru, Mexico and Chile, and led earlier by the Minister of International Trade and Industry Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed.

Here in Chile, Wan Latiff is the Chief-de-Mission for the event and among others, includes one-to-one business meetings for participating Malaysian companies.

He said the Malaysia-Chile Free Trade Agreement (MCFTA) is the first and only bilateral FTA between Malaysia and a Latin American country which came into force on Feb 25, 2012.

He said Malaysia and Chile have agreed to progressively reduce or eliminate tariffs on respective industrial and agricultural products.

Upon coming into force, 90.2 per cent of tariff lines have a zero per cent tariff and by 2016, 98 per cent will fall into this category.

Also present at the seminar was Malaysian Ambassador to Chile, Datuk Mohamad Rameez Yahaya, President of the Santiago Chamber of Commerce, Peter Hill and Trade Commissioner, Matrade Santiago, Noor Ezzwane Ahmad.

Wan Latiff said 12 business representatives from 10 companies are part of the trade mission to Chile.

The companies are IX Global Services Sdn Bhd (IT System Integration Services), Lite Bulk Sdn Bhd (Bulk Logistics), Mazsoni Global Sdn Bhd (Building Materials), Pitaberry Sdn Bhd (Health Beverages), Seni Daya Woods Industries (M) Sdn Bhd (Children's Furniture), and Star Medik Sdn Bhd (Medical Devices), Tamarind Furniture Sdn Bhd (Rubber wood furniture), VG Metal Technology (M) Sdn Bhd (Oil and Gas), VG Offshore Containers International (Oil and Gas) and UNIRAZAK, a financial Services provider for Sukuk (Islamic Bonds).

Ubicado en el sudeste asiático, Malasia consta de trece estados y tres territorios federales, con un área de 329.847 kilómetros cuadrados. Tiene una población de veintisiete millones de habitantes en un territorio dividido en dos regiones por el mar de la China Meridional: la de Malasia Peninsular se encuentra en la península malaya y limita al norte con Tailandia y al sur con Singapur, y la de Malasia Oriental, por su parte, está situada en la zona septentrional de Borneo y limita al sur con Indonesia y al norte con Brunei.

PROTON [PRESENTACIÓN EN CHILE]

El gigante de MALASIA está de vuelta



BIENE BIENVENIDO

Desde 1998 que no se veía la marca Proton en las calles y carreteras de Chile. Pero a contar de esta semana aparecerán tres versiones de su modelo Prevé, la más nueva y evolucionada de esta marca de Malasia que llegó a Chile a mediados de los 90 y que permaneció hasta fines de 2006, ganándose un debido prestigio en el mercado nacional por la calidad del producto, sus buenas terminaciones y su fiabilidad.

Pues bien, 18 años después, de la mano de Andino Motor, una empresa del Grupo Kasimanan, la marca regresa al país con el sedán Prevé, un nombre derivado de la palabra en inglés "prova", que significa "probar" y que para Proton es una apuesta en mercados desafiados como el nuestro.

El Prevé es un sedán de tamaño medio, que mide 4.543 mm de largo, 1.786 mm de ancho, 1.524 mm de alto y una distancia entre ejes de 2.650 mm.

Destaca su diseño sobrio, de líneas de frías y una zaga muy bien lograda, en donde el borde de la tapa del maletero forma un suave spoiler integrado a la silueta, que incide en el comportamiento

LA MARCA PROTON REAPARECE EN CHILE CON SU MODELO PREVÉ, UN SEDÁN MEDIANO DE ATRACTIVO DISEÑO Y PRESTACIONES.

El interior muestra un tablero muy limpio, con un cuadro central de instrumentación tras el volante de buen tamaño e iluminación, contribuyendo la información de velocidad y tacómetro en forma analógica (con agujas) y la de otras funciones en forma digital, con un atractivo color rojo.

En la mecánica, hay dos opciones de motor. Las dos versiones de entrada, Prevé Standard (\$10.490.000) y Executive (\$11.990.000), ofrecen un cuatro cilindros aspirado de 1.6 litros y 107 caballos de potencia a 5.250 rpm, con un par torsional de 150 Nm a 4.000 rpm y asociado a una transmisión mecánica de 5 velocidades.

La versión Prevé Premium (\$14.490.000) apunta más alto y presenta un motor de 1.6 litros con turbo, que produce 138 caballos a 5.000 rpm y un

dinámico del auto. El frontal ofrece un dibujo con un diseño geométrico variado, con gran tendencia a las angulaciones extremas, pero muy bien lograda.

El interior muestra un tablero muy limpio, con un cuadro central de instrumentación tras el volante de buen tamaño e iluminación, contribuyendo la información de velocidad y tacómetro en forma analógica (con agujas) y la de otras funciones en forma digital, con un atractivo color rojo.

En la mecánica, hay dos opciones de motor. Las dos versiones de entrada, Prevé Standard (\$10.490.000) y Executive (\$11.990.000), ofrecen un cuatro cilindros aspirado de 1.6 litros y 107 caballos de potencia a 5.250 rpm, con un par torsional de 150 Nm a 4.000 rpm y asociado a una transmisión mecánica de 5 velocidades.

La versión Prevé Premium (\$14.490.000) apunta más alto y presenta un motor de 1.6 litros con turbo, que produce 138 caballos a 5.000 rpm y un

par de 205 Nm a 4.000 vueltas. Tiene una transmisión automática CVT de 7 velocidades y la opción de operación manual mediante clavijas tras el volante (paddle shift).

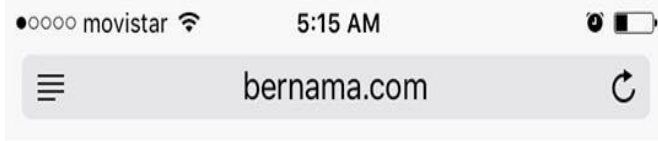
La performance de este modelo en términos de velocidad fue de 0 a 100 km/h en solo 8,1 segundos.

Proton To Relaunch Its Models In Chile This Saturday

SANTIAGO, May 24 (Bernama) -- Proton Holdings Bhd is set to re-enter the Chilean market with the relaunch of its models here this Saturday after almost a two-decade hiatus.

Malaysian Ambassador to Chile Datuk Dr Mohamad Rameez Yahaya said Proton will bring 1,000 units of selected models into the market and expects to generate RM68 million in sales.

"This indicates that Malaysia-Chile relations continue to grow stronger," he said in his address at the Seminar on Business Opportunities with Malaysia, organised by the Malaysian External Trade and Development Corporation (Matrade) here on Monday.

Mohamad Rameez said Chile is the only Latin America country to have signed a free trade agreement with Malaysia which makes the country an even more important trade partner for Malaysian companies planning to venture into the continent.

Speaking to Bernama later, Mohamad Rameez said Proton had appointed Andes Motor, a member of Kaufman Group, as its distributor here.

On March 1, Proton announced that it would re-enter the Chilean market this year after its last exports of the Proton Wira in 1998.

It would begin with the sales launch of the Proton Preve and Exora in May, followed by the Proton Saga in November 2016.

On trade prospects between the two nations, Mohamad Rameez said bilateral trade between Malaysia and Chile is expected to grow further as both are members of the Trans-Pacific Partnership trade pact.

"There will be more opportunities for either side to explore, and Chile will remain as one of the Malaysia's top trading nations in Latin America as it is the most stable country in terms of politics, economic freedom, transparency and competitiveness," he said.

Mohamad Rameez also expressed his commitment to bringing more Chilean entrepreneurs to Malaysia and ASEAN.

"For example, last week I had a meeting with the owners of SUGAL, a tomato and fruit paste manufacturer here, who told me that they were going to Malaysia on June 1 to seek out business opportunities," he said.

The seminar was held in conjunction with Matrade's Trade and Investment Mission to Chile, led by Strategic Planning Senior Director Wan Latiff Wan Musa.

Also present at the seminar were President of the Santiago Chamber of Commerce Peter Hill and Matrade Trade Commissioner in Santiago Noor Ezzwane Ahmad.

The 12-member delegation is on a 14-day mission from May 14 to three countries, namely Peru, Mexico and Chile.
