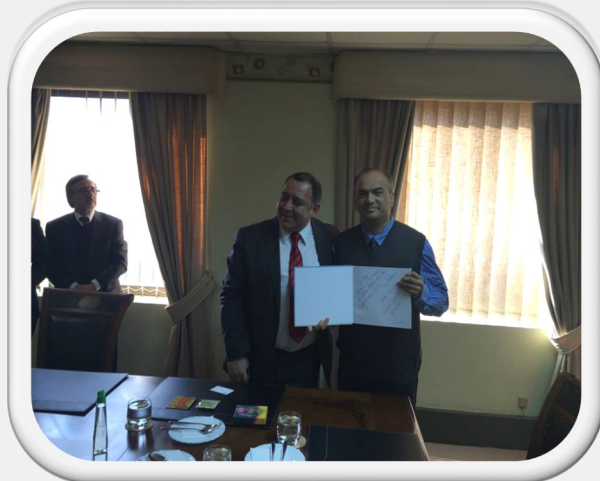

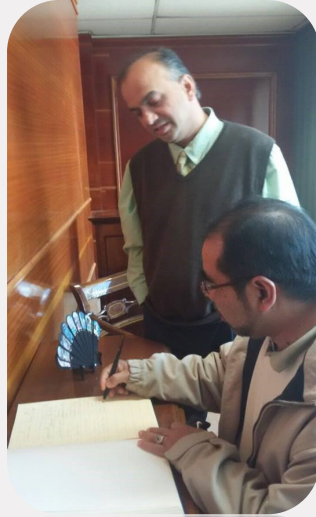

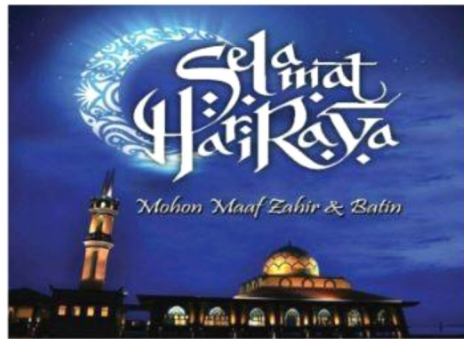

 NEWS CONFERENCE BY THE UNITED STATES  
 ATTORNEY GENERAL:  
 US SEEKS TO RECOVER MORE THAN \$1 BILLION  
 INVOLVING MALAYSIAN SOVEREIGN WEALTH  
 FUND**

YB Dato' Sri Anifah Hj. Aman, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia held a meeting with His Excellency Joseph Y. Yun, Ambassador of the United States of America at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Putrajaya today, in relation to the news conference by the United States Attorney General on 20 July 2016 on the filing of a civil suit seeking to recover more than \$1 billion in assets allegedly linked to 1MDB.

YB Dato' Sri Anifah also mentioned that Malaysia has yet to receive any request from the US to obtain any information or evidence for the filing of the case.

However, Malaysia is ready to fully cooperate with any lawful investigation of Malaysian companies in accordance with international protocols, provided that Malaysia and the United States work together on this matter.

Malaysia highly values its bilateral relations with the United States and calls on the US to recognize the various steps taken by the Government of Malaysia to address the 1MDB issue.

## Chile tiene "muchas similitudes" con países del Sudeste Asiático, dice ex presidente

SANTIAGO, 27 jul (Xinhua) -- El ex presidente chileno Eduardo Frei aseguró hoy en esta capital que Chile tiene "muchas similitudes" con los países miembros de la Asociación de Naciones del Sudeste Asiático (ASEAN).

"Chile tiene muchas similitudes con los países de la ASEAN y hay que ir convergiendo para poder lograr lo que todos queremos, que es el desarrollo de nuestros países", indicó Frei en el foro "ASEAN y sus 50 años: Una mirada desde Chile".

El ex mandatario (1994-2000) dijo que "más del 50 por ciento del comercio de Chile se realiza con Asia Pacífico y debemos aprovechar las oportunidades no sólo en el intercambio comercial, sino en todas las áreas".

Este evento coincidió con el anuncio de que la ASEAN aceptó la solicitud de Chile para adherirse al Tratado de Amistad y Cooperación de ese bloque regional, integrado por Filipinas, Indonesia, Malasia, Singapur, Tailandia, Vietnam, Brunei, Laos, Myanmar y Camboya.

Frei recordó que durante su gobierno, en 1994, junto con Singapur, se iniciaron las conversaciones para el denominado Tratado P-4, que es el antecesor del reciente concluido Acuerdo de Asociación Transpacífico (TPP, siglas en inglés) de libre comercio, "el cual no significa ningún cambio para Chile".

El TPP se está discutiendo en todos los parlamentos de los 12 países que lo suscribieron en febrero pasado en la ciudad neozelandesa de Auckland: Estados Unidos, Japón, Australia, Malasia, Brunei, Nueva Zelanda, Singapur, Vietnam, Canadá, Chile, México y Perú, recordó.

El ex mandatario sostuvo que su país "no va a cambiar si ratifica el TPP, porque tiene tratados de libre comercio con el resto de las 11 naciones que lo firmaron".

A su juicio, "la ASEAN está buscando un acuerdo similar de libre comercio y en el resto de Asia se va a llegar a un acuerdo de ese tipo, y Chile va a ser también parte de ese acuerdo, los cuales van a dibujar la nueva realidad del comercio mundial".

Además, Frei destacó que "la Alianza del Pacífico es una realidad fuerte y contundente y, a mi juicio, es el proceso de integración más importante que se ha desarrollado en América Latina".

Se trata de la alianza formada por Chile, Perú, Colombia y México, indicando que "a la reciente cumbre presidencial en la ciudad chilena de Puerto Varas llegaron a 49 los países observadores, lo que indica la importancia de ese proyecto integracionista".

Recordó que, en su reciente visita por países de la ASEAN, el tema central de las conversaciones con los líderes fue "cómo vamos a avanzar en una convergencia entre nuestros países", reiterando las oportunidades de cooperación que pueden abrirse entre ellos y la Alianza del Pacífico.

El ex mandatario concluyó que hay un futuro no solamente con el Foro de Cooperación Económica de Asia Pacífico (APEC), integrado por 21 economías, sino también con las naciones de ASEAN, y Chile es "un país plataforma" de integración.

En el foro, los embajadores de Indonesia, Philemon Arobaya; de Malasia, Mohamad Rameez Bin Yahaya; de Tailandia, Saroj Thanasunti; de Vietnam, Ngo Duc Thang; y la encargada de negocios de Filipinas, Raisa Mabayo, expusieron experiencias sobre la integración de sus países en la ASEAN.

Al dar la bienvenida a los participantes, el director de la Academia Diplomática, embajador Juan Somavía, relató que hay testimonios de contactos de Chile con Asia desde el siglo XIX, destacando que "con ASEAN, con sus 600 millones de habitantes, se abre un nuevo espacio constructivo de cooperación y para profundizar los lazos bilaterales".
