On 25 April 2016, a seminar on “Business and Investment opportunities in Kedah, Malaysia” was held at the Austrian Economic Chambers (WKO) in Vienna. The seminar was jointly organized by the Embassy of Malaysia in Vienna and the Malaysian Investment Development Authority (MIDA) based in Munich, as well as with the support of the Kedah State Government, Kulim Technology Park Corporation (KTPC) and Invest Kedah. The seminar aimed to create awareness of the investment opportunities and promote Kedah as a potential investment hub to the business community in Austria. As many as 30 participants from various business sectors participated in the seminar. Kedah State Government was represented by YBhg. Dato' Ku Rahman Ku Ismail, State Minister of Kedah and YBhg. Dato' Ahmad Shukri Tajudin, Managing Director of Invest Kedah as well as YBhg. Dato' Annuar Mohd Saffar, President of the KTPC. Mr. Robert Luck, the WKO's Manager for Southeast Asia were also in attendance.

H.E. Dato' Adnan Haji Othman, Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Malaysia in Austria delivered a welcoming speech at the seminar, which among others, highlighted the recognition Malaysia received from various international organisations towards its economic policies, while the representatives from Kedah encouraged the participants to explore the unique investment opportunities in Kedah. 4th GERMAN/AUSTRIAN MALAYSIA ROUNDTABLE MEETING, 17 May 2016

On 17 May 2016, the Embassy of Malaysia in Vienna and the Malaysia External Trade Development Corporation (MATRADE) based in Frankfurt, Germany jointly organised the 4th meeting of the German/Austrian Malaysian Roundtable (GMRT) in Linz, Austria. The Austrian Raiffeisen Bank Group offered its office headquarters in Linz to host the GMRT. Several foreign companies based in Malaysia participated in the GMRT.
