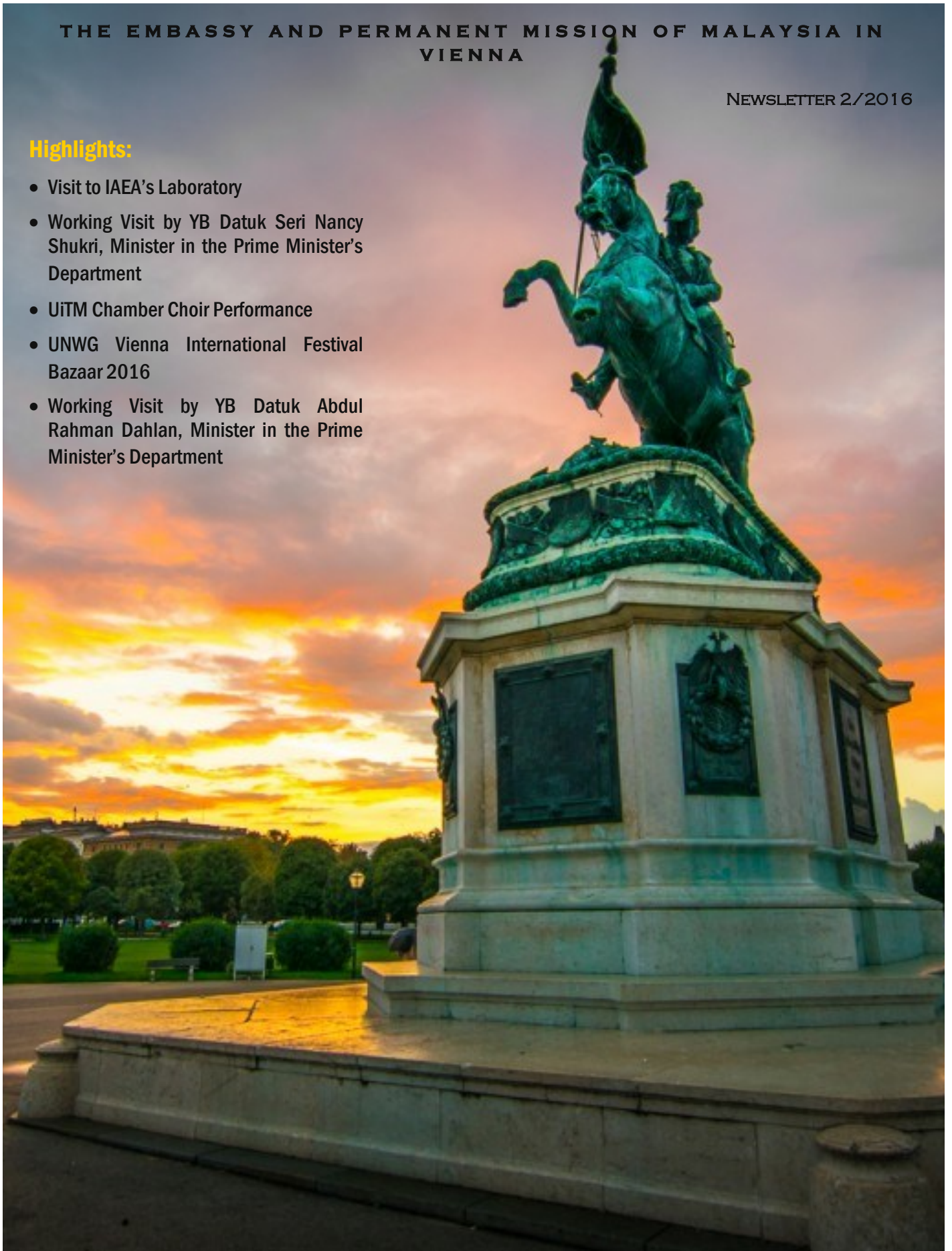

## HARI SUKAN NEGARA



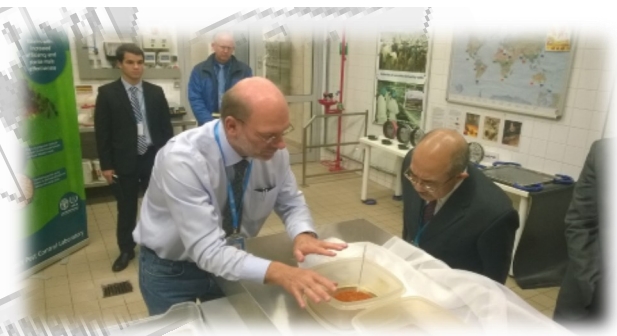

## END-OF-YEAR HIGH TEA

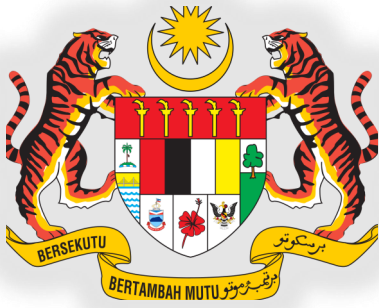
