WORKING VISIT BY YB DATO' SRI ANIFAH AMAN TO WARSAW, POLAND



YB Dato' Sri Anifah Hj. Aman, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia, undertook a Working Visit to Warsaw, Poland on 9 April 2016. The working visit included a tour and briefing at the Malaysian Government property at Szwolezwow 1 Street and the Chancery building followed by a lunch session at the Residence (Rumah Malaysia). The last official working visit of YB Minister to Poland was from 11-12 July 2013.

PRESENTATION OF CREDENTIAL OF H.E. DATO' AHMAD FADIL SHAMSUDDIN

The Ambassador of Malaysia to the Republic of Poland, His Excellency Dato' Ahmad Fadil Shamsuddin, presented his letters of Credence to His Excellency Andrzej Duda, President of the Republic of Poland on Tuesday, 14 June 2016. The presentation of credentials was held at an official ceremony at the Belvedere Courtyard, Warsaw. His Excellency Dato' Ahmad Fadil is the 11th Head of Mission for the Embassy of Malaysia in Warsaw, Republic of Poland.



MALAYSIA CULTURE DAY IN KRAKOW, POLAND

The Embassy of Malaysia in Warsaw, in collaboration with the Manggha Museum of Japanese Art and Technology organized the Malaysia Culture Day which was held on 22 May 2016 in Krakow, Poland. The Malaysia Culture Day saw a combination and concerted efforts from the Embassy of Malaysia in Warsaw and Tourism Malaysia based in Frankfurt, Germany to promote Malaysia as a tourist destination and Malaysia's cultural diversities with its multi-cultural society.



WORKING VISIT BY YB DATO' SRI ROHANI ABDUL KARIM, MINISTER OF WOMEN, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPEMENT

YB Dato' Sri Rohani Abdul Karim, Minister of Women, Family and Community Development of Malaysia (KPWKM) was on a working visit to Poland in conjunction with the 2016 Global Summit of Women (GSW) in Warsaw from 9 - 11 June 2016. Malaysia hosted the Summit in 2013. YB Minister also had the opportunity to attend "Program Ramah Mesra" with Malaysian diaspora and students at Rumah Malaysia on 8 June 2016.

The program was hosted by Ambassador Dato' Ahmad Fadil Shamsuddin with the attendance of 80 Malaysian diaspora and students in Warsaw. The session began with an iftar followed by maghrib prayer, dinner and concluded with an interaction session conducted by YB Minister on Malaysia's current issues.



CHINESE NEW YEAR PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

In Conjunction with the Chinese New Year festival, Malaysian Students Society in Poland (AMAR POLAND) had organized a Chinese New Year photography contest on 2 February 2016 to all Malaysian residing in Poland via Facebook page "Komuniti Malaysia in Poland". This contest has received a positive response especially from the Malaysian students. The Home Base Staff (HBS) of the Embassy of Malaysia in Warsaw were requested to be the judges for the contest. The winner of the contest were Emerald Chao (Medical student from the Medical University of Warsaw), Hidayatur Afifah (Medical student from the Medical University of Warsaw) and Harison Xavier (Medical student from the Jagiellonian University in Krakow).



ASEAN COMMITTEE IN WARSAW (ACW) WORKING LUNCH

ASEAN working lunch was held on 19 April 2016 and was hosted by the Indonesian Ambassador, His Excellency Peter Gontha. The Indonesian Ambassador is scheduled to handover the ASEAN Chairmanship for Warsaw's Chapter to Malaysia in May 2016.



BADMINTON TOURNAMENT ACADEMIC OF CHAMPIONSHIP OF WARSAW AND MAZOWSZW (AMWiM) 2016

Ms. Emerald Chao, a fourth year medical student from the Warsaw Medical University was crowned runner-up at the Academic Championship of Warsaw and Mazowszw (AMWiM) Badminton Tournament on 8 May 2016. The women single finals took place at the WAT sports complex between Emerald Chao of Warsaw Medical University and Joanna Solowinska from the Warsaw Polytechnic.

The first round of the tournament started in December 2015 and followed by the second round in March 2016 and the last round was held in May 2016. The tournament was participated by students from universities in Warsaw and Mazowszw.



SARAWAK'S GOVERNOR OFFICE SUPPORTED TWO IFTARS IN WARSAW

The Embassy of Malaysia in Warsaw and the Office of TYT Governor of Sarawak co-hosted two Iftars at the Milanow Mosque and the Blue City Mosque on 21 and 24 June 2016, respectively. Both breaking of fast events at the two mosque in Warsaw were sponsored by the Office of TYT Governor of Sarawak. More than 300 people comprising the locals, foreigners and Malaysia students attended the Iftars.



The Iftars have given a good opportunity for Malaysian students and diaspora to interact with the local communities and other Muslims in opinion-exchange on culture and other issues. There are more than 180 Malaysian students studying in Poland and majority of them are studying a several medical universities in Warsaw and Krakow. More than 90 percent of the total Malaysian students in Poland are under PSD and MARA scholars.



ESTABLISHMENT OF MALAYSIA CULTURE CLUB IN POLAND

The Embassy of Malaysia in Warsaw is set to establish "Malaysia Culture Club" in Poland under the patronage of the Hon. Dato' Seri Mohamed Nazri Aziz, Minister of Tourism and Cultural Malaysia. One of the main purpose of the establishment of the club is to enhance and strengthen the people to people contact between Malaysia and Poland through tourism and cultural promotions and exchange programs. The membership of the club is open to all Polish and Malaysian professionals and student residing in Poland.
