DIGITAL TV SERVICE IS BACK ON AIR

The digital TV service which was disrupted since 11 October 2018 in several states including Kelantan, Pahang, Terengganu, Negeri Sembilan, Perak, Melaka, Sabah and Sarawak has now been restored and is accessible to viewers.

As reported earlier, the service disruption was due to commercial issues between MYTV Broadcasting Sdn. Bhd (MYTV) and Telekom Malaysia (TM).

On 22 November 2018, I instructed the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) to facilitate discussions between parties to resolve this issue as soon as possible.

A series of discussions were held between MCMC, MYTV and TM in the last few weeks.

MCMC has now reported that MYTV and TM have reached an agreement to resolve their commercial differences to enable digital TV services to be made available by today.

I am glad that both TM and MYTV have reached a mutual resolution on their issues so as to ensure that the digital TV service can be viewed by the rakyat starting from today. Ultimately, service delivery to the people should be given the highest consideration and priority by all service providers.
