

# Strive for unity, urges Tun Hussein

**KUALA LUMPUR, Wed.** — Former Prime Minister Tun Hussein Onn today called on all parties in the Government and component parties in the National Front to work hard to achieve unity among the people under Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mahamad's leadership.

Speaking at a dinner given in his honour by the MCA, Tun Hussein said he was grateful to his Cabinet colleagues who gave co-operation and advice while he was Prime Minister.
