

Sime files another suit against ex-CEO

Sime Darby Bhd and three of its subsidiaries filed another lawsuit against its former chief executive officer Ahmad Zubir Murshid - this time over losses suffered in the Bakun Dam project.

Also named as defendants are former executive vice-president Mohd Shukri Baharom and group utility and energy and chief financial officer of the Energy and Utility division Abdul Rahim Ismail.

The three other plaintiffs are Sime Engineering Sdn Bhd, Sime Darby Holdings Bhd and Sime Darby Energy Sdn Bhd.

According to the statement of claim, RM92.2 million in damages are being sought.

The suit was filed at the new commercial court by the law firm Zaid Ibrahim and Co.

This is the second suit filed by Sime Darby against them.

Yesterday, the country's largest conglomerate sue Ahmad Zubir and four others over RM2.1 billion losses incurred in three projects.

It sought at least RM332 million in damages over losses suffered by the company in the Qatar Petroleum Project (QP), the Maersk Oil Qatar (MOQ) Project and its 'Marine Project' which involves the construction of vessels for the MOQ.
