

Choo Keong describes Karpal as flip-flop MP

Wangsa Maju member of parliament Wee Choo Keong has described Karpal Singh as a flip-flop MP for frequently changing his views related to Anwar Ibrahim.

Wee in his blog said it had been reported that Karpal (Bukit Gelugor MP) had asked for the opposition leader to be investigated for sodomy when Anwar was the deputy prime minister in 1997.
