

**PM to meet Christian group tomorrow amid furore**

Prime Minister Najib Abdul Razak is due to meet a Christian group tomorrow to discuss the 'Christian conspiracy' claim that was front-paged by Utusan Malaysia last Saturday.

Council of Churches of Malaysia (CCM) secretary Rev Hermen Shastri (left) told the Chinese media today that the PM's Office initiated the meeting to find a solution to an issue that has created a political storm.

Saying that it will be a closed-door meeting, he declined to divulge the place and the time.

In addition, only certain CCM members have been invited to attend, he said, adding that he himself will not be at the meeting.

However, Herman said the PM's Office should meet Utusan editors to find out why they had raised the issue in the first place.

He also slammed the daily for having 'fabricated' news and playing with fire.

The news report was based on blog postings by two pro-Umno bloggers.

They claimed that the DAP and Christian leaders had hatched a plot to take over the country, abolish Islam as the religion of the federation and install a Christian as prime minister.
