

Nazri: Rosmah's exposure boosts national image

The involvement of the prime minister's wife, Rosmah Mansor, in international conventions and seminars is seen as something positive as it elevates the country's image, the Dewan Rakyat was told today.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Mohamed Nazri Abdul Aziz said the invitations were a recognition and tribute to Malaysia's policies and strategies in the advancement of education, early education and child care, women's development and welfare.

He said through the involvement, Malaysia could share its experiences and achievements in these fields.
