

Najib copied cost of living NKRA from us, say MPs

Pakatan Rakyat today accused the prime minister of copying their policy moves by announcing similar efforts to curb rising cost of living.

However, PAS Kuala Selangor MP Dzulkefly Ahmad (left), who spoke after the coalition's weekly alternative budget working committee meeting, said that the BN government is free to "plagiarise" at will "for the good of the rakyat".

"Yesterday (PM Najib Abdul Razak) wrote on his blog that the (upcoming federal) budget will be focused on easing the burden of the rakyat.

"This is a reaction to our announcement last week, when we said our alternative budget will focus on raising disposable income for the bottom 60 percent of households earning less than RM3,000," he told reporters in Petaling Jaya today.

Fellow committee member and PKR Lembah Pantai MP Nurul Izzah Anwar added that the cost of living national key results area announced on July 27 was also a direct response to Pakatan.

"Just before that we had a roundtable discussions with experts on rising cost of living," she said.
