

Umno vows to 'bury' Khalid's political career in Port Klang

SELANGOR Winds of change in the Pelabuhan Klang state seat has now painted a clear message that the area will return to Barisan Nasional (BN) in the 13th general election.

The residents in the area are thirsty for development under the BN government and were impatient to vote for BN, and this development would 'bury' Abdul Khalid Ibrahim's political career on May 5, said his challenger.

Nasaruddin M Zin (right) who is the BN candidate for the state seat said, Abdul Khalid's failure to carry out his duties as menteri besar and state assemblyperson for Ijok had tarnished his credibility.

"He did not bring any change in Ijok as the menteri besar and then he elopes to Pelabuhan Klang. He will not win here because he is not a local.
