

PKR: Explain how Altantuya's case was 'dealt with'

PKR Wanita wants Women, Community and Family Development Minister Rohani Karim to explain exactly what she means by saying the murder of Mongolian national Altantuya Shaariibuu has been "dealt with".

"As far as the people are concerned, the main culprit is out there and he is the prime minister of Malaysia," said wing chief Zuraida Kamaruddin.
