

**Ibrahim Ali raps DAP for questioning Islamic subject**

Perkasa president Ibrahim Ali has described Kampar MP Ko Chung Seng as being rude and disrespectful of the Agong for questioning the introduction of Islamic Civilisation studies in private higher learning institutions.
