

PAS issues dare to DPM over beach-front site

KUALA BESUT Deputy premier Muhyiddin Yassin has been challenged to instruct Terengganu Menteri Besar Ahmad Said to take back a beach-front site that has allegedly been handed out to four BN representatives in the state.

Issuing the demand today, PAS central committee member Dr Dzulkefly Ahmad said the site should revert to the state government as it is a "high-value asset".

By doing so, the BN-led state government would prove that it is delivering on the coalition's 'people first' slogan and not "victimising people", Dzulkefly told a press conference in Kuala Besut today.

NONEPAS had levelled the claim the BN Four had received 1 ha of beach-front land each in Besut.

It named Besut MP Idris Jusoh (left), former Besut MP Abdullah Md Zin, Hulu Besut assemblyperson Nawi Mohamad and former Kota Putera assemblyperson Muhammad Pehimi Yusof.

Nawi has since admitted to receiving the land from the state government but claimed that this was in line with common practice.
