

Najib gets red marks from PAS

PAS vice-president Mahfuz Omar said there is no "clear commitment" in Prime Minister Najib Abdul Razak's administration to bring about national reconciliation even 100 days after GE13.

"I don't see him committing to do something about it (national reconciliation) but he is instead more (committed) to fanning the embers in politics," Mahfuz said.

Najib's performance was "very disappointing" as the government was focused on "white elephant" projects that did not benefit the citizens, he told a press conference at the PAS headquarters in Kuala Lumpur today.

The Pokok Sena MP said the people were burdened with the rising cost of living and high crime rates.

The prices of goods too were skyrocketing, and that was very burdensome on their earnings, Mahfuz added.
