

Selangor PKR chides state gov't over transfer of PKNS duo

Selangor PKR has trained its guns on the Selangor state government for transferring two top Selangor State Development Corporation (PKNS) officials over the controversy surrounding Selangor PKR chief Azmin Ali's removal from the PKNS board.

In a statement today, Selangor PKR information chief Shuhaimi Shafiei, who is also the Sri Muda state assemblyperson, said that the transfer was akin to "punishment without trial".

"We consider this an embarrassing act (by the state government) and does not represent PKR as a principled and democratic party," he said.

Yesterday, Selangor Menteri Besar Abdul Khalid Ibrahim announced that PKNS general manager Othman Omar and executive secretary Norita Mohd Sidek have been transferred, pending a probe into Azmin's removal from the board.
