

Pakatan youth urges cops to reopen TBH's case

After the recent landmark judgement by the Court of Appeal on Teoh Beng Hock's case, Pakatan Rakyat Youth has urged the police to reopen investigations on the case.

The court had overturned the coroner's open verdict following the inquest into the death of the DAP political aide five years ago.

"We, Pakatan Rakyat Youth, unanimously urge the authorities, especially the police, to re-open the investigation regarding the case.

"We urge the IGP to ensure a detailed and transparent investigation to be made quickly, in order to find the truth of the death of Teoh Beng Hock," the body, made up of PKR, PAS and DAP Youth, said in a joint statement today.

Meanwhile, leaders from it will also meet Home Minister Zahid Hamidi on September 11th in Putrajaya to seek an explanation on the recent wave of arrests under the Sedition Act.
