

Guan Eng tells Hadi to leave Pakatan

DAP secretary-general Lim Guan Eng has asked PAS president Abdul Hadi Awang to leave Pakatan Rakyat if Hadi insists on pursuing his Private Member's Bill for hudud to be implemented in Kelantan.

Lim told reporters in the Parliament lobby today that Hadi, in tabling the bill in Parliament, was not doing so for as his individual democratic right but was acting to show "Pakatan Rakyat was being cheated".

"If he wants to still do it as an MP, he can do so, but not on behalf of Pakatan.

"If Hadi still wants to do it, he should leave Pakatan and do it on his own," he said.

Lim (left) reiterated that DAP was not trying to stop Hadi's democratic right to table the Private Member's Bill.

Earlier today, DAP declared that would be cutting off all ties with Hadi over the PAS presidents 's attitude on the hudud controversy.

However, DAP said, it would maintain its ties with with PAS.

Meanwhile, PAS Kota Raja MP Dr Siti Mariah Mahmud described the DAP decision as "weird".

"You want to sever ties with the head of the party, but maintain ties with the tail. It's weird," Siti Mariah said.
