

Anina may face action over hard-hitting speech

Umno secretary-general Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor has warned that action will be taken against delegates whose speeches breached party ethics.

Speaking to reporters, Tengku Adnan said he is in the process of studying the speeches made during the annual meets of Umno divisions.

"We are looking into the speeches of all divisions; we will see if any of them deviated from party ethics and action will be taken," he added.

Tengku Adnan, who is popularly known as Ku Nan, was commenting on the hard-hitting speech of Langkawi Umno delegate Anina Saaduddin.

In her speech, Anina repeatedly said Umno president Najib Abdul Razak had figuratively urinated on the party over the RM2.6 billion deposited into his personal bank accounts.

Kedah Menteri Besar Mukhirz Mahathir has conceded that her speech was crude but said the message behind it was important and urged Umno to be open to what the grassroots had to say.

Meanwhile, on the party's general assembly, Tengku Adnan said he was confident it can be held by year-end.

"We are waiting for the divisions to finish their meetings," he said at the Federal Territories Hari Raya open house in Putrajaya today (photo).

He said the party will hold a meeting about the AGM later this month.
