

## **1MDB critic Pua claims BN wants him out of PAC**

DAP lawmaker and vocal 1MDB critic Tony Pua believes that BN wants to have him booted out of the Public Accounts Committee (PAC).

However, the Petaling Jaya Utara MP maintained he has not done anything wrong as a member of the PAC

"I don't know whether to be worried or not. It's clear that BN wants me out of PAC.

"I've never breached standing orders, and never leaked anything that has not been revealed to the public," he told a press conference at the Parliament lobby today.

Pua was asked to comment on newly-minted PAC chief Hasan Arifin's remarks that the committee's next meeting will discuss Pua's fate.

Earlier at a separate press conference, DAP secretary-general Lim Guan Eng chastised Hasan for taking aim at Pua.

"The Rompin MP should not start his career as PAC chief by doing silly investigations.

"The PAC should investigate 1MDB, Jho Low, those responsible, not Tony Pua," he said.

Hasan has since clarified that he does not have the power to remove Pua from the committee.
