

Cabinet meeting in Kuching to support S'wak, says Zahid

S'WAK POLLS | Deputy Prime Minister Ahmad Zahid Hamidi said the weekly cabinet meeting which will be in Kuching tomorrow, is to support Sarawak under the leadership of Chief Minister Adenan Satem.

Ahmad Zahid said it was suggested by Prime Minister Najib Razak.

“He (Najib) feels that he needs to be around and he would like to get the commitment from every cabinet minister. Therefore, we agreed to his suggestion.

“The cabinet meeting tomorrow is to show our commitment and moral support to the state government’s leadership. This is also for us to translate our support to Adenan and also his vision.

“With the support of the federal government under Najib, we are here to be with the people of Sarawak,” he said during his visit to the Bernama media operations centre in Kuching today.

The last cabinet meeting held outside Kuala Lumpur was in 1999 in Langkawi during the Langkawi International Maritime and Aerospace Exhibition (Lima).

Culture and Tourism Minister Nazri Abdul Aziz recently said that the cabinet meeting would be held here as there are eight federal ministers from Sarawak, who are involved in the state election campaign.

Nazri said it was also convenient for other ministers in the relevant portfolios to be around during the election.
