

Zahid: Voters mature enough to reject politics of hatred

Ahmad Zahid said Chinese voters in Sarawak too supported the various initiatives introduced by Sarawak Chief Minister Adenan Satem, more fondly known as Tok Nan.

The victory, he said, showed the Chinese community wanted their aspirations voiced in the state legislative assembly by BN Chinese candidates and not the opposition alone.

"Thank you for giving another five years to Tok Nan. I am sure he will continue his struggle for the people of Sarawak, including the Chinese community," he said.
