

Najib: Final date for Budget 2017 submission extended to Sept 21

Those who wished to submit their suggestions or contribute ideas for the 2017 Budget can still do so until Sept 21, although it was announced that the last day for submission was Sept 15.

The new date was announced by Prime Minister Najib Abdul Razak in his Facebook and Twitter postings today.

"I have therefore decided to extend the period for contributing ideas and suggestions for the Budget 2017 to Sept 21. Do not miss the opportunity and start submitting proposals to *bajet2017.najibrazak.com*," he said.

Ideas contributed thus far covered topics like cost of living, healthcare, housing, urban well-being, transportation and infrastructure, economic development and education.

Najib is scheduled to table Budget 2017 in Parliament on Oct 21.
