

PM urges people to register for Covid-19 vaccination

Prime Minister Muhyiddin Yassin today called on the people to immediately register for the National Covid-19 Immunisation Programme.

He said the public should take advantage of the immunisation programme that provides Covid-19 vaccines free of charge.

The prime minister (photo, above) said the public should not be afraid of getting vaccinated, as he himself and his wife, Norainee Abdul Rahman, have completed the full vaccination regimen, recently.

“I would like to call on all the people, including in Pagoh to get themselves inoculated. My wife and I have completed the two doses of the vaccine...look, we are still the same (in good health).

“There is no problem, we eat and sleep normally...don't be afraid (to take the

vaccines),” he said at the Jom Ke Sekolah programme for the Pagoh parliamentary and Gambir state constituencies, as well as the Mara Education Foundation’s corporate social responsibility programme at Kompleks Sukan Pagoh, today.

Muhyiddin who is also the Pagoh member of Parliament said, according to a briefing given by Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Khairy Jamaluddin and Health Minister Dr Adham Baba yesterday, about seven million people have registered for the National Covid-19 Immunisation programme.

He hoped that the number would soon reach 10 million and subsequent target of 70 to 80 percent of Malaysians (about 26 million) to receive the vaccines.

“When many people get vaccines, our country will be much safer. The government has no other intention but to help the people. The people must also help themselves, for their own safety and health,” he said.
