

Covid-19 (Sept 24): 14,554 new cases, lowest R-naught this month

COVID-19 | The Health Ministry today reported 14,554 new Covid-19 cases.

As of yesterday, the R-naught for Malaysia has dropped to 0.90 - the lowest this month so far. An R-naught of less than 1.00 suggests that the spread of Covid-19 was decelerating.

The only regions where the R-naught was above 1.00 are **Pahang** and **Perlis**.
