

Next year I turn 100, says Dr M in message for 2025

Next year, former prime minister Dr Mahathir Mohamad will turn 100 years old.

"Alhamdulillah, so far, I have been blessed with relatively good health, still able to stand, walk, and think clearly," he said.

Mahathir stated that a century is an incredibly long period, and he feels fortunate to have lived through significant moments in the nation's history.

"From my teenage years to today, I have had the opportunity to fight and work for the well-being of the country," he said.

However, he emphasised that the fighting spirit of its people, who possess self-identity, dignity, and a commitment not to sacrifice the land or the honour of the nation had contributed to the nation's success.

Mahathir also urged Malaysians to continue upholding noble values, being principled, showing respect for one another, and adhering to the laws and constitution of the country.

"Resolve to be better Malaysians, responsible, and loving towards our country,"

he advised.
