

Cops record statement from Wee over Perkasa report

MCA Youth chief Datuk Dr Wee Ka Siong was called up by the police today to give statements on three police reports lodged by the Malay right-wing group, Pertubuhan Pribumi Perkasa Malaysia (Perkasa), recently.

When contacted by Bernama, Wee said he gave the statement for about one hour at the Dang Wangi District Police Headquarters.

He was accompanied by MCA Youth secretary-general Datuk Chai Kin Seng and Federal Territory MCA Youth chief Chew Lian Keng.

"I just revealed the truth, nothing to hide. I am prepared to give full cooperation to the police at any time," he said.

Dang Wangi district police chief, Asst Comm Zulkarnain Abdul Rahman, when contacted, confirmed that a statement was taken from Wee concerning the Perkasa report, but declined further comment.

Perkasa recently lodged a police report on Wee's statement which they claim would cause racial tension and jeopardise national harmony.
