

Johor police question Anwar over sultan's pix in banners

Three Johor police officers today questioned PKR de facto leader Anwar Ibrahim in his office at the party's headquarters in Tropicana, Petaling Jaya.

NONEAnwar (far left in photo), who is also Opposition leader, arrived at 10.38am accompanied by three bodyguards.

Just before 11am, he was joined by party information chief Latheefa Koya and treasurer William Leong, who are also his lawyers.

A senior police officer accompanied by two others (below) from the Batu Pahat district police headquarter arrived at 11.44am at the PKR headquarters.

Anwar was questioned on the mysterious appearance of 'phantom banners in Johor that depicted Anwar alongside Johor PKR chief Chua Jui Meng and Johor Sultan Ibrahim Iskandar.

The banners, which Umno has accused PKR of being responsible for, also declared that the state PKR supports Chua for menteri besar.

However, Chua and the state PKR have denied involvement and pointed their finger at Umno instead.

Anwar is being questioned as a witness under Section 112 of the Criminal Procedure Code.

NONThe police are investigating the matter after receiving nearly 40 police reports over the banners, many of which were placed along the route that the sultan had taken during the recent Kembara Mahkota Johor tour of the state.

The lead officer interviewing Anwar was the same policeman who last week interviewed Johor PKR head Chua Jui Meng over the same matter.
