



Tengku Fakhry disappointed over revoking of title

Tengku Muhammad Fakhry Petra said today that he is disappointed that his brother Sultan Muhammad V had revoked his Tengku Temenggong title and all awards that had been conferred to him.

He said he received a note from the Kelantan State Secretary yesterday notifying him of the Kelantan Sultan's decision.

"I am disappointed but not surprised that he has seen fit to take such an action," he said in a statement today.

Tengku Muhammad Fakhry (*right*) claimed that his brother had no power to withdraw his title and awards as he deemed his father Tuanku Ismail Petra was still the Sultan.

Sultan Muhammad V was proclaimed as the Sultan of Kelantan on Sept 13 by Kelantan Menteri Besar Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat at the Istana Balai Besar in Kota Baru to replace his father, Tuanku Ismail Petra.

The former Sultan of Kelantan, Tuanku Ismail Petra Ibni Sultan Yahya Petra, last month filed a petition at the Federal Court registry in Putrajaya to seek the intervention of the apex court to declare as "unconstitutional" the proclamation of his eldest son as the new Sultan Kelantan.
