



BN gearing for snap polls, says Anwar

The government's latest postponement of the goods and services tax (GST) is a 'major' indicator that snap polls are around the corner, said PKR *de facto* chief Anwar Ibrahim.

"There is a major possibility of snap general elections and I anticipate that tomorrow's budget is going to be an election budget," he told a press conference at the Parliament House lobby today.

Anwar, a former deputy premier and finance minister, pointed out that the GST was a poorly-constructed bill that would only burden Malaysians while contributing little towards generating economic activity.
