FREE BY-ELECTIONS What's happening in the by-election campaigns in the parliamentary constituency of Batu Sapi and the Galas state seat? Quotable quotes, planned events and unplanned incidents as they occur in P185 and N45.

8am-5pm (Batu Sapi): Postal voting begins.

9am (Galas): Federal government to hold a ceremony to give six ambulances, 10 fogging machines, a portable ultrasound machine and a haemodialysis machine to the Gua Musang Hospital and Health Department. A press conference is scheduled at 1.30pm after the ceremony.

11am (Galas): DAP launches a new set of leaflets which highlight the manhandling of activists of the 'Malaysians for Beng Hock' group last Saturday.

Its campaign coordinator Vincent Wu said 2,000 copies of the leaflets will be distributed to three Chinese-majority areas: Kampung Baru Gua Musang, Bandar Lama and Kampung Baru Pulai.

12noon (Batu Sapi): BN candidate Linda Tsen to have lunch with the press at Sri Libaran.

2pm (Batu Sapi): Linda Tsen to visit at Taman Mawar phases 5, 6 and 7.

3pm (Galas): Health Minister Liow Tiong Lai to hold meet-and-greet session with locals.
