

PAS MP kicked out of Parliament over pork issue

Kuala Selangor PAS member of parliament Dzulkefly Ahmad was booted out of the Dewan Rakyat today over an uproar in the House over the religious faith of the boy who was caned for bringing fried rice and pork sausages to school.



Dzulkefly (*left*), angered over the argument raised by Zulkifli Noordin (Ind-Kulim Bandar Baharu) that the boy's father is a Muslim who goes by the name of 'Nor Azman Abdullah' and that it is “not proper” for a Muslim to have brought “haram” (forbidden) food.

“If the father is Muslim the boy is also a Muslim by default,” said Zulkifli.

However, Dzulkefly said that the issue in question was not the religious faith of the boy but the senior school administrator's act of punishing the boy by caning him for it.

Zulkifli then accused “PAS of endorsing Muslims to eat pork”, provoking Dzulkefly to lash out at the former.

Dzulkefly refused to budge despite continuously being told to resume his seat by deputy speaker Wan Junaidi Jaafar, who then ordered Dzulkefly to leave the House until after lunch-time, which ends at 2.30pm.
