Wan Azizah in her speech said initially PKR was considered a mosquito party and nobody bothered about it but now that the party has grown into a strong national political party to be reckoned with, people are jumping on the bandwagon for a political stand in the party.

NONEShe also touched on the ongoing second sodomy case that her husband Anwar Ibrahim is now facing, and said that he is facing an uphill fight to see justice done.
