

**MB Khalid sacks Klang municipal councillor Tee**

SHAH ALAM – Selangor Menteri Besar Khalid Ibrahim has sacked embattled Klang municipal councillor Tee Boon Hock, who came under the limelight recently for allegedly issuing support letters to friends and a relative to help them get business.

Announcing this Wednesday, Khalid said the state government's decision to sack Tee was made after investigations revealed he had indeed breached a code of ethics by issuing the letters.

Tee found himself in hot water after The Star exposed last month that the former Selangor DAP organising secretary had used Selangor exco member Ronnie Liu's letterhead and seal to issue the incriminating support letters.

One of the letters was issued to help a company, in which his son was a partner, to get a contract from the Klang Municipal Council (MPK).

Tee was Liu's special assistant at the time the letters were issued. He was also expelled by the DAP last week over the matter.

According to Khalid, Tee's sacking as an MPK councillor was effective Aug 6. He also said Liu had been asked to leave the room when Tee's matter was being discussed at the exco meeting Wednesday.

Liu had alleged that Tee used his letterhead and seal without his knowledge.

Meanwhile, Selangor police said investigations into the alleged misuse of support letters from Liu's office are ongoing despite the investigation papers having been submitted to the Attorney-General's office.

Selangor DCP Khalid Abu Bakar said police had yet to obtain the three original documents from Liu's office in connection with the issue.

"The documents we received earlier were not the original copies needed in the investigations," he said.

DCP Khalid also appealed to anyone in possession of support letters in connection with the case to hand them over to the police as soon as possible.
