

DAP's Tony Pua receives letter-bullet threat

PETALING JAYA - A threatening letter accompanied by a live M-16 bullet were received by DAP publicity chief Tony Pua (left) at his service centre in Damansara Utama here Wednesday.

The MP for Petaling Jaya Utara and an aide have lodged police reports at the Damansara police station.

It is learnt that the note was type-written and sent in a brown envelope. It was reportedly posted from Tangkak, Johor.

Lawmaker Pua told reporters that "both my statement and my assistant's were recorded last evening."

Pakatan Rakyat leaders reportedly have expressed shock at this latest threat against one of their lawmakers.

According to Malaysian Chronicle, Umno Youth chief Khairy Jamaluddin immediately tweeted about the threat against Pua who shared the same Oxford University background as him.

""Heard about the love letter. Hope you're OK & made necessary reports. This is not the politics I signed up for. Take it easy," tweeted Khairy.

The note says: "Tony Pua Kiam Wee. You are so brave? What do you want now? You better watch out. . . We know about your family, your house, your office, your car."

Meanwhile, Segambut MP Lim Lip Eng was reported by The Star as saying that police believed the threat could be over Pua's statement calling for the abolishment of the bumiputra discount for houses costing more than RM500,000 and commercial property costing more than RM2 million.

According to Lim, police confirmed that the bullet has a serial number and was locally-made for the MK16 rifle.

Petaling Jaya police chief Asst Comm Arjunaidi Mohamad confirmed receiving the reports.
