

Anak files police report against PM

KUALA LUMPUR - The National Association for Children Settlers (Anak) has lodged a police report Thursday against Prime Minister Najib Abdul Razak.

According to Free Malaysia Today, the PM and his Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Ahmad Maslan and Felda chairman Yusof Noor were alleged to have committed "contempt of court."

The report was reportedly related to the Federal Court's landmark decision which ordered the Federal Land Development Authority (Felda) to pay RM11 million compensation to 354 settlers.

Lawyer's absence

Najib and the other two were said to have committed contempt of court for claiming that Felda did not win the case due to its lawyer's absence and therefore, was deprived the chance to defend itself.

Anak president Mazlan Aliman, who lodged the police report, refuted Najib's claim by saying that although the lawyers did not attend the High Court hearing, Felda was represented by lawyers when the case was appealed to the Court of Appeal and Federal Court.

The report was filed at Dang Wangi district police headquarters by Abdul Rahman Ramli from Felda Serting in Negeri Sembilan.
