

**Chua: These Facebook accounts not mine**

KUALA LUMPUR - MCA president Dr Chua Soi Lek has warned the public against fake Facebook accounts impersonating various political figures, including himself.

He lamented that there were at least four fake and unofficial Facebook accounts created under his name.

The MCA president clarified in a statement Friday that he has stopped managing the only one Facebook account he signed up for after it got hacked.

"I wish to clarify that I have not created nor authorised anyone to manage a new Facebook account and that an official announcement will be made should I create a new account for myself," he said.

Malicious intentions

Chua condemned the act and welcomed authorities to take action against those "unscrupulous persons" who did so with malicious intentions.

The MCA president is not the only victim as fake accounts of the social-networking site have surfaced involving several top political figures.

They include Prime Minister Najib Abdul Razak, Inspector-General of Police Musa Hassan, and Mohamed Nazri Abdul Aziz (Minister in the Prime Minister Department).

"The public must be more cautious when they are invited to "like" or "add" any public figures so that they will not be manipulated or fooled by them.
