

Syed Husin chooses not to defend PKR post

PETALING JAYA - PKR deputy president Senator Dr Syed Husin Ali has decided not to defend his post in the upcoming party election in November.

According to *The Star* report, he will remain active in politics while making way for the younger generation to take on.

"Truly, I wish to see a younger and more active person to succeed me, although at the age of exactly 74, which falls next week, Insya Allah, I sometimes do not feel that old," he said in a statement on Tuesday.
