

Those who continue to disunite Sarawak BN will fail, says SUPP chief

MIRI - The Sarawak United People's Party (SUPP) president, Dr George Chan is unperturbed by the efforts of certain groups who try to create disunity among the Barisan Nasional (BN) component parties in the state.

He said such a tactic was bound to emerge whenever it was close to a general election and had failed in the past to disrupt the strong bond enjoyed by the BN parties.

"It (disunity in BN) is not going to happen. In our component parties, being leaders we know each other so well. So no one can make us fight (with each other)," he told reporters here after a meet-the-people session at the SUPP Miri headquarters on Tuesday.

He was asked to comment on the emergence of posts made on a popular internet social networking site carrying instigating remarks apparently to stir dissatisfactions among members of the state BN component parties.

Besides SUPP, the other BN component parties in Sarawak are the Parti Pesaka Bumiputera Bersatu (PBB), Parti Rakyat Sarawak (PRS) and Sarawak Progressive Democratic Party (SPDP).

Dr Chan, who is also the Sarawak Deputy Chief Minister, said that he preferred to explain the facts on Sarawak's achievements under the BN government rather than dwell on the fabricated issues made up by such groups.

He said Sarawak would not have achieved the level of development that it enjoyed now if the BN component parties had failed to work with each other. - Bernama
