

**Nurul Izzah can now run for PKR No.2 spot**

PETALING JAYA - First, she was urged to run for the PKR deputy presidency but was told she was not eligible for lack of nominations. On Thursday, it was confirmed that Nurul can now run for the No. 2 spot because she has garnered enough nominations.

According to PKR secretary-general Saifuddin Nasution Ismail on Thursday, PKR de facto leader Anwar Ibrahim's daughter has qualified to stand in the upcoming elections.

Saifuddin has confirmed Nurul's eligibility for the party's second highest post, thanks to a late nomination submission by the Semporna division which was accepted.

It is understood that party candidates must get at least two nominations to be eligible to contest in the elections.

News blog *Malaysian Chronicle* on Thursday quoted Saifuddin as saying, "There has been a lot of mischief caused by wrong reporting. The political bureau accepted because the nominations came one day late. No harm in that.

"Of these nominations, some were for Nurul. This means that she qualifies to go for the deputy presidency. Whether she does is up to her, she has until October 16 to decide. We hope the press will not play up or twist the issue," Saifuddin said.

Lembah Pantain MP Nural's other nomination was from Keningau, the Sabah division.
