

**Honda Civic Hybrid price reduce by RM21,000**

KUALA LUMPUR - Malaysians can purchase the Honda Civic Hybrid RM21,000 lesser than the current price in conjunction with the recent announcement of Budget 2011 which exempted import duty and excised duty.

It was announced by Honda Malaysia Sdn Bhd that the hybrid car will be sold at an on-the-road price of RM108,980 in Peninsular Malaysia and RM109,980 in East Malaysia.

Bernama reported that the price revision is in line with the government's decision to extend tax incentives for hybrid vehicles until Dec 31, 2011.

"As the pioneer in introducing the hybrid technology to the Malaysian market, we are pleased with the government's decision to allow full exemption of import duty and excise duty as announced in the recent Budget 2011," said Honda Malaysia President and Chief Operating Officer, Rohime Shafie.

These exemptions are certainly timely, as Honda is looking into expanding its hybrid vehicle line-up in Malaysia, he added.

Honda Malaysia believes that the tax incentives offered by the government will encourage more Malaysians to opt for environmentally responsible technology that is also fuel-efficient.
