

'Not yet but soon,' says Zaid

UPDATED KUALA LUMPUR - Zaid Ibrahim, who was earlier reported to have decided to leave Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR), has not officially quit the party yet but did not discount the possibility of resigning from the party soon.

He told Bernama that he was still considering the matter.

"(I have) not yet (resigned from the party), perhaps soon," he said in an SMS sent to Bernama on Monday.

Meanwhile, The Malaysian Insider reported that party secretary-general Saifuddin Nasution said the party has yet to receive an official notification of Zaid's decision to leave PKR.

We have not received any letter from Zaid so far informing us of his intention to quit the party," Saifuddin was quoted by the news website.

According to Pakatan Rakyat (PR) protem secretary Anthony Loke, the former Umno leader will cease to be a member of the coalition if he quits the party as "Zaid was not there (PR) as an individual but by virtue of being a PKR member."
