

Husam Musa denies report that he welcomes Zaid into PAS

KUALA LUMPUR - PAS vice-president Husam Musa refuted on Tuesday a Bernama report which claimed that he would support Zaid Ibrahim to join the party.

Husam, also PAS central committee member, has demanded the news agency to withdraw the report.

"I am disturbed by the report and would like Bernama to withdraw the report," he said and MI reported.

Bernama in its news report published on Monday, entitled 'PAS prepared to accept Zaid Ibrahim as member, says Husam,' has quoted Husam as saying that he welcomes Zaid to join the Islamist party.

Husam was also said to have "revealed that PAS had previously offered Zaid a place in the party but he preferred to be with PKR."

"He (Zaid) is in a position to join any party...we did invite him to join PAS before but he declined, so it's up to him now to join which party," he was quoted in the article.
