

**PKR: Azmin and Izzah close to victory as polls ending soon**

KUALA LUMPUR - The ongoing party polls for Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) will be entering its final lap of polling this coming weekend which saw vice-president Azmin Ali and Lembah Pantai MP Nurul Izzah Anwar leading their respective races.

Azmin Ali is currently ahead of the deputy presidential race with 11,350 votes while his rival, Mustaffa Kamil Ayub is left far behind with only 3,401 votes.

Nurul Izzah, daughter of de-facto leader Anwar Ibrahim, is currently leading the bid for one of the four PKR's vice president post with 11,042 votes.

Trailing behind her are: Batu MP Tian Chua (9,524 votes, Kuantan MP Fuziah Salleh (7,878) and Penang deputy chief minister Mansor Othman (7,448).

Since October 29, 30,000 members from 165 divisions had voted for the party leadership, representing just 8.4 per cent of the party's population, Harakahdaily reported.

PKR Congress is scheduled from Nov 26 to Nov 28 to announce the results.
